Dear Colleague:

As you know, election of Officers for the term to commence on January 1, 2011 and ending on December 31, 2012 will take place at the upcoming meeting of the International Board of Governors to be held in conjunction with the XXXVII World Biennial Congress, **Thursday, November 18, 2010 beginning at 8:30 a.m. at the Diamond Hotel in Manila, Philippines.**

We are pleased to inform you that the Nominating Committee has held its meeting with representation of all six Federations and we have considered every recommendation sent by the National Sections. We have formulated a Slate of Nominees for the positions on the ICS Governing Bodies, which will become vacant as of January 1, 2011. Enclosed is a copy of the Slate of Nominees.

The Nominating Committee conducted its meeting according to the Constitution and Bylaws of the College. Our deliberations were open and honest and we thought that the representation should be on the broadest possible global basis.

In accordance with the ICS Constitution and Bylaws, said slate of Nominees is being sent to the President and Secretary of each National Section and to each Federation Secretary – “not less than 60 days prior to the date of the next International Board of Governors meeting”.

Article III, Section 7, paragraph four of the Bylaws states:

.....A final meeting of the Committee on Nominations shall be held within the three (3) days immediately prior to the day of the International Board of Governors meeting to consider further recommendations for nominations by national sections or to consider changes in nominations that may occur because of the death, inability, or refusal or undesirability of a nominee to stand for election to office.

Additional nominations for office may be made by any Voting Governor by submitting the name of such nominee, together with a curriculum vitae of said nominee, to the Nominating Committee not less than five (5) days prior to the opening of the Biennial meeting of the International Board of Governors, and the Nominating Committee shall have the privilege of commenting on the qualifications of such additional nominee, but the Nominating Committee shall report the names of each such nominee (in addition to the nominee of the Nominating Committee for such position) together with its comments, but such nominee shall stand as an additional nominee by a Voting

Governor for each such position, it being understood that the Nominating Committee shall not have the right to veto placing any such name in nomination.

Only Fellows of the College in good standing shall be eligible for election to office. No nominations will be accepted from the floor.

In addition, the Nominating Committee has made a change in its approach to slating candidates for election. For many years the Nominating Committee each year adopted a practice that those slated for positions by the Nominating Committee would also be considered slated for every lesser position for which they are eligible and qualified. This year, the Nominating Committee voted NOT to slate candidates for any other or lesser position than the one(s) for which they are specifically slated. In other words, the Nominating Committee slated candidates for a higher office will NOT be considered also slated for any other lesser position by the Nominating Committee. If they are not elected for the position(s) for which they are slated by the Nominating Committee, they will NOT be considered to stand for election for any lesser position unless they are duly nominated by any Voting Governor for such lesser position. Thus nominations for a lesser position must be made timely (not less than five (5) days prior to the opening of the Biennial meeting of the International Board of Governors), by any Voting Governor. There are still no nominations from the floor. Please, take notice of this change.

We eagerly anticipate your participation in Manila, your presence is most important during these proceedings.
